Prayer Prompts
April 27-May 3, 2020

Monday, April 27, 2020

Scripture – Exodus 18:19-21 - Listen now to me and I will give you some advice, and may God be with you. You must be the people's representative before God and bring their disputes to him. Teach them his decrees and instructions, and show them the way they are to live and how they are to behave. But select capable men from all the people—men who fear God, trustworthy men who hate dishonest gain—and appoint them as officials over thousands, hundreds, fifties and tens.

Prayer Prompt – Just as Moses needed assistance to lead Israel, so Pastor Tyler needs our Elder Team to help him lead Forest Baptist Church well. The Elder Team has a possible new member, Mark Hernandez, who has been nominated by the Elder Search Committee. The Corona virus has interrupted our deliberation process. Pray for Mr. Hernandez and for God's timing for the congregation to have the opportunity to act on the search committee's recommendation.

Tuesday, April 28, 2020

Scripture – Colossians 1:9-10 - For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience

Prayer Prompt – Paul's prayer for the Colossian church is a prayer you can pray for yourself, your prayer partner, your Sunday School class, and for your church. Pray for insight into how we can bear fruit in every good work, getting to know more about our Father, and given strength by his Spirit to endure with patience our present circumstances.

Wednesday, April 29, 2020

Scripture – Psalm 117:1-2 – Praise the Lord, all you nations; extol him, all you peoples. For great is his love toward us, and the faithfulness of the Lord endures forever. Praise the Lord.

Prayer Prompt – The shortest Psalm embraces the world. Ask the Lord to receive the praise of all nations. Prayer for the people of Los Limones Guatemala that they will realize his great love for them. Praise God for his faithfulness in sending the gospel to them through Forest Baptist Church. Prayer for our next team that they will be able to travel in July as planned.

Thursday, April 30, 2020

Scripture – Colossians 2:5 - For even though I am absent in body, nevertheless I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your good discipline and the stability of your faith in Christ.

Prayer Prompt – We are absent physically from each other due to stay-at-home orders; however, pray that Forest Baptist Church's membership will maintain their spiritual discipline in daily prayer and Bible reader and that their faith would remain stable in the face of current events.

Friday, May 1, 2020

Scripture—Psalm 37:18-22 – The Lord knows the days of the blameless, and their inheritance will be forever. They will not be ashamed in the time of evil, and in the days of famine they will have abundance.

Prayer Prompt – Pray for ministries that provide for the poor, such as Lighthouse Community Services, to have the supplies they need to continue their work. Forest Baptist Church does have a discreet benevolence ministry; pray for Pastor Joe to have wisdom as he administers this ministry.

Saturday, May 2, 2020

Scripture – Psalm 105:1-4 – Oh give thanks to the Lord, call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples. Sing to him, sing praises to him; speak of all his wonders. Glory in his holy name; let the heart of those who seek the Lord be glad. Seek the Lord and His strength; seek his face continually.

Prayer Prompt – Pray for the Jill Murphy as she leads our Music Ministry. She is producing very creative song sets that she puts up on Facebook and they are available on the church's website. You can also look up hymn collections on your computer or if you have a hymnal at home, pull it down and spend some time singing.

Sunday, May 3, 2020

Scripture – Psalm 103:1-5 – Bless the LORD, O my soul, And all that is within me, *bless* His holy name.

Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget none of His benefits; Who pardons all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases; Who redeems your life from the pit, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and compassion; Who satisfies your years with good things, *So that* your youth is renewed like the eagle.

Prayer Prompt – Bless the Lord for the salvation he has provided to us. Tell him how you appreciate the benefits that he has provided (the peace, the comfort, the joy). Thank him for pardoning your sins and for carrying you through your body's infirmities. Tell the story of how you were saved. How has he shown you lovingkindness and compassion? Thank him for giving you the strength you have today.
