Prayer Prompts for  
May 25-31, 2020

**Monday, May 25, 2020**

**Scripture: 1 Peter 4:3-5** – For the time already past is sufficient for you to have carried out the desire of the Gentiles, having pursued a course of sensuality, lusts, drunkenness, carousing, drinking parties and abominable idolatries. In all this, they are surprised that you do not run with them into the same excesses of dissipation, and they malign you; but they will give account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.

**Prayer Prompt** – Pray for our youth and young adults at Forest Baptist Church. They may be young in the faith and trying to navigate their new living reality as a redeemed person while going to school or work with friends who may not understand the changes. They may be mocked and scoffed at for having embraced faith in Jesus Christ.

**Tuesday, May 26, 2020**

**Scripture: 1 Peter 4:7-9** – The end of all things is near; therefore, be of sound judgment and sober spirit for the purpose of prayer. Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins. Be hospitable to one another without complaint.

**Prayer Prompt** – Pray for the fellowship of Forest Baptist Church that (1) we would continue to have fervent love for one another and (2) we would be hospitable to one another. As restrictions on gathering together are eased, we are going to be assembling ourselves together beginning June 7. The chairs in the sanctuary will be configured to maximize social distancing while together. Pray for those who are preparing for the first service back in the church. Pray that we will love one another enough to not complain about the accommodations to the rules. Pray that we will put others ahead of our own desires.

**Wednesday, May 27, 2020**

**Scripture: John 3:35-36** – The Father loves the Son and has given all things into His hand. He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.

**Prayer Prompt** – Pray for those on our Wednesday night prayer list who need salvation. Shelley can e-mail the Wednesday night prayer sheet to you if you need it. Pray that they would believe in the Son.

**Thursday, May 28, 2020**

**Scripture: Psalm 33:20-22** – Our soul waits for the Lord; He is our help and our shield. For our heart rejoices in Him, because we trust in His holy name. Let your lovingkindness, O Lord, be upon us, according as we have hoped in You.

**Prayer Prompt** – Pray for God’s blessing to be upon Forest Baptist Church; that we as a congregation will focus on Him and look to him for guidance and protection. Ask the Lord to give us the gift of faith in His holy name.

**Friday, May 29, 2020**

**Scripture: Romans 8:14-17** – For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, “Abba! Father!” The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

**Prayer Prompt** – Thank God for our adoption as children of God. Pray for the families of Forest Baptist Church who have undergone or are currently undergoing the process of legal adoption of children into their families. Pray for children in the foster system who need a mommy and a daddy. Pray that more Forest Baptist families will feel the call to adoption.

**Saturday, May 30, 2020**

**Scripture: Psalm 33:12** – Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people whom He has chosen for His own inheritance.

**Prayer Prompt** – Pray for many in the United States to come to faith in Jesus Christ. Pray for North American Mission Board Church Planter Billy Levengood in Oxford, Pennsylvania. He planted Redemption Community Church. He is asking “for wisdom as to the best place to meet (when we’re able) since we were meeting in a school, and we’re not sure when we might be able to do that again”. Pray for a place for the church to meet.

**Sunday, May 31, 2020**

**Scripture: John 7:37-39** – On the last day of the festival, the great day, while Jesus was standing there, he cried out, “Let anyone who is thirsty come to me, and let the one who believes in me drink. As the scripture has said, ‘Out of the believer’s heart shall flow rivers of living water’.” Now he said this about the Spirit, which believers in him were to receive, for as yet there was no Spirit, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

**Prayer Prompt** – Does your soul thirst for God’s presence? Pray for God the Holy Spirit to fill you like water fills a vase. Pray for him to fill Tyler, Joe, Steve, Reed, and Jill, as they lead our worship and discipleship. Pray for him to fill our elders, Fred, Donnie, Paul, and Mark as they lead small groups and support the ministries of our church. Ask the Lord to give them wisdom and grace as they prepare for the first Sunday in June.
